

# Basic Commands

The following quick commands can be executed in the MongoDB shell. To do this, you must connect to the server or container and call the CLI with the correct authorizations:

```
mongo
```

## List Databases

```
show dbs;
```

## Use Database

```
use <yourdatabasename>;
```

## List Collections

```
show collections;
```

## Use Collection

```
use <yourcollectionname>;
```

## Show all Entries

```
use <yourdatabasename>;  
db.<yourcollectionname>.find();
```

## Delete Database

```
use <yourdatabasename>;  
db.dropDatabase();
```

## Delete Collection

```
use <yourdatabasename>;  
db.<yourcollectionname>.drop();
```

## Insert Data

```
use <yourdatabasename>;  
db.<yourcollectionname>.insertOne({"id":"123456789","name":"test","email":"test@test","password":"p49QSIB  
nEtJA3lD8kH5NYe"})
```

## Duplicate Database

```
use <yourdatabasename>;  
db.<yourcollectionname1>.find().forEach(function(d){  
db.getSiblingDB('<yourcollectionname2>')['<yourcollectionname1>'].insert(d); });
```
